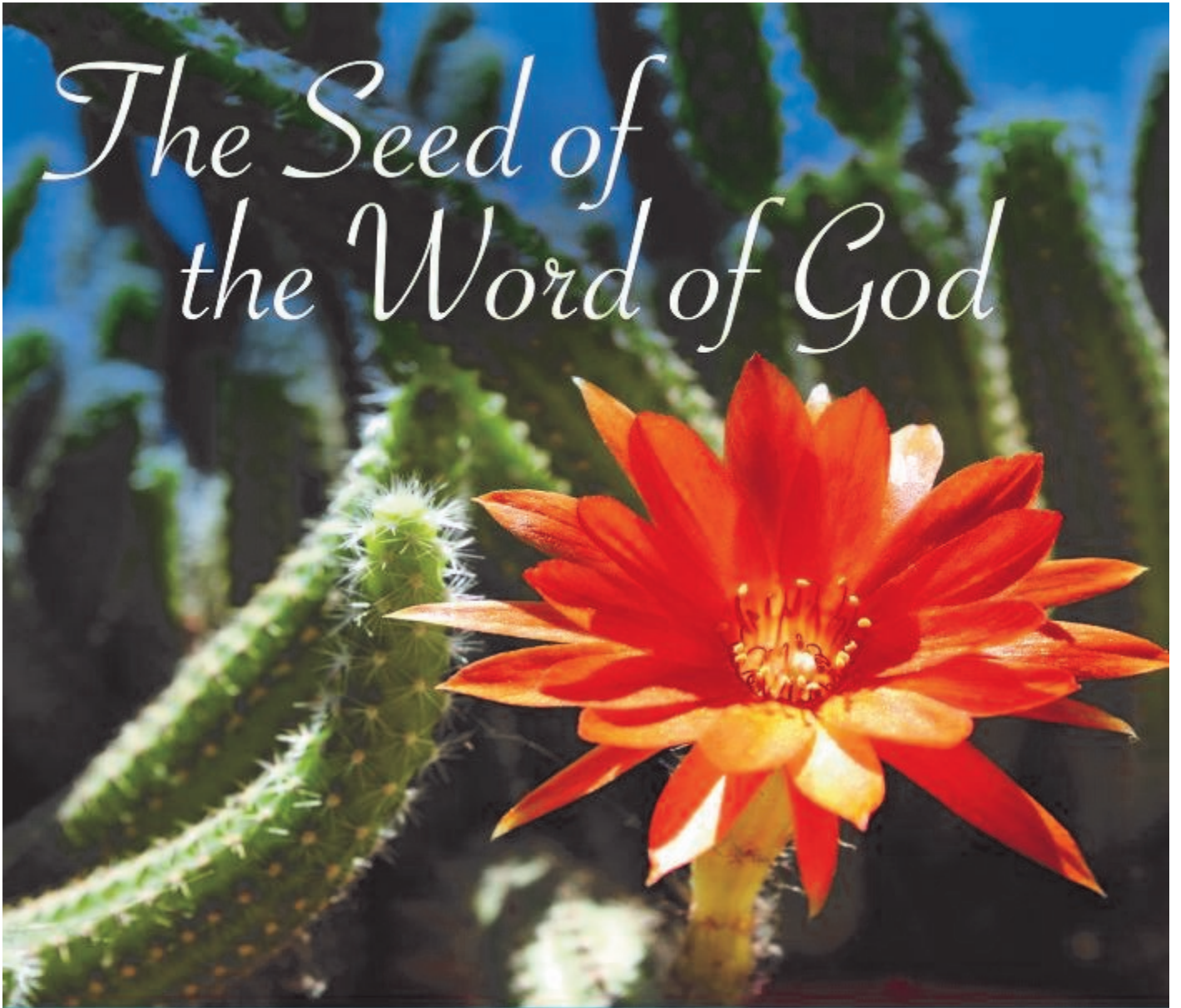

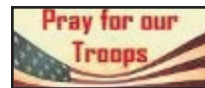

**Did You Know?
Who Are the Abusers?**



Estimates are that approximately 60% of abusers
are men, 15 to 20% are women, and 20 to 40% are men and
women acting together. So while men are indeed the major-
ity of sexual abusers, it is dangerous to underestimate the risk
that female sexual abusers also pose to children. Among
educators, 57.2% of abusers are male, and 42.4% of abusers
are female.
